Wet hands & forearms.

Use running water as hot as you can stand it. It should be at least 100°F (38°C).

Apply soap.

Use enough soap to build up a good lather.

Scrub for 10-15 seconds.

Scrub hands and forearms for 10-15 seconds. Be sure to scrub under your fingernails and between your fingers.

Rinse.

Rinse hands and arms using warm water.

Dry Hands.

Dry hands and arms with a single-use paper towel or hand dryer.

Use a paper towel to turn off the sink.

By using the paper towel to turn the faucet, you will prevent your hands from getting recontaminated.
